On September 17, 1787, the delegates to the Constitutional Convention met for the last time to sign the document they had created: The United States Constitution. Today, we celebrate Constitution Day every September 17th in honor of this historical event.

The purpose of Constitution Day is to commemorate the creation and signing of the supreme law of the land and to honor and celebrate the privileges and responsibilities of U.S. citizenship for both native-born and naturalized citizens. The goal of our Constitution is to “form a more perfect Union” and is found in the Preamble of that document.

The Preamble reads..... “We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.”
