MAP Testing Schedule: MAP testing will take place Monday, April 25 to Thursday, May 5. This year, our students will be testing in their content area classrooms. Please help us by avoiding appointments and ensuring students are in attendance - especially during their testing blocks.

No Cell Phones/Smart Watches: Due to state testing requirements, students must leave their cell phones in their lockers during testing. We suggest students leave their phones at home or secure them in their locker. Also, students will not be allowed to use e-readers or cell phones **after** the test for reading. We encourage you to find a good paperback or hard copy of a book to have on hand should a student finish testing early.

Rest and a good breakfast: Please help your student get plenty of rest and eat a good breakfast, especially during testing days. If things are busy at home in the morning, please plan to pick up breakfast at school.




